

According to art.13 par. 1 and 2 of general data protection regulation dated April 27th, 2016 (GDPR), I hereby inform you that:

3. Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:
 - A. to execute purchase-sale transactions, following an agreement, order, sales service, according to the legal basis of art.6. par.1. letter b of GDPR,
 - B. to issue financial and accounting documents that confirm a purchase-sale transaction, according to the legal basis of art.6. par.1. letter c of GDPR,
 - C. to pursue claims, according to the legal basis of art.6. par.1. letter f of GDPR,
 - D. for marketing purposes, following a legal interest of the Administrator, according to the legal basis of art.6. par.1. letter f of GDPR,
 - E. for statistical and analytical purposes aimed at researching sales potential, according to the legal basis of art.6. par.1. letter f of GDPR,
 - F. to process complaints, according to the legal basis of art.6. par.1. letter f of GDPR.
4. Your personal data will be transferred to tax offices, banks, carrier companies, Polish Post, courier companies, law firms, the National Revenue Administration, customs offices, translators, chartered auditors, auditing companies, companies that handle sales, orders, and invoices through software and electronic platforms, companies that offer sales and marketing services.
5. Your personal data will not be transferred to countries outside the European Union.
6. Your personal data will be processed:
 - Purpose A. According to The Accounting Act.
 - Purpose B. According to The Accounting Act.
 - Purpose C. Until claims are outdated.
 - Purpose D. Until cooperation is ceased.
 - Purpose E. Until the end of the business relationship.
 - Purpose F. Until the end of the complaint processing procedure and according to The Accounting Act.
7. You have the right to access the contents of your personal data, to correct it, remove it, limit its processing, the right to transfer data and to express an objection (applicable to purposes C-F).
8. Your provision of personal data is voluntary, but necessary to fulfill the obligation of the Administrator and to execute the agreement.
9. You have the right to file a complaint to the Chairman of Data Protection Office, if you suspect that the processing of personal data is a breach of legal regulations.
10. Your personal data will not be processed in an automatic manner or as profiling technique.
